



## CLIENT GUIDELINES FOR WRENTHAM FOOD PANTRY

1. The food pantry is open for food distribution Saturdays from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm and serves residents of Wrentham only. We close promptly at 12:00.
2. In an effort to help the environment and reduce our expenses, we ask clients to bring their own shopping bags (when possible).
3. Clients are responsible for the supervision of their children at the pantry.
4. **INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Clients who behave in a discourteous or disruptive manner, use abusive language, or come to the pantry under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be served and will be asked to leave. Up to 3 warnings will be given at the discretion of the Food Pantry BOD. **INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR WILL RESULT IN THE TERMINATION OF FOOD PANTRY SERVICE.**
5. If you are unable to get to the pantry, your food may be picked up by someone else, with a note, preferably by someone already designated as a family member on your application form. No one under 18 is allowed to pick up food.
6. **HOLIDAYS:** Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter, special meals are provided. **If you sign up for a holiday meal and do not pick up your meal on the designated day, you will not be eligible for the next holiday meal.**
7. Selling or misuse of pantry food will result in immediate termination of service.
8. It is not the responsibility or policy of the Pantry to provide transportation to clients. Any volunteers or clients, who do provide rides, do so at their own risk.
9. **No smoking is allowed on pantry/church property.**
